 Important Make sure to send all official transcripts from other colleges to


DVC prior to scheduling your counseling appointment so we can plan around your previous coursework.

What is an Associate Degree for Transfer?

A transfer degree can guarantee admission to the CSU system, and comes with other perks, like junior standing if you transfer into a similar program, and sometimes even a GPA boost if you are applying to a competitive school.

How much does PACE cost?

DVC is very affordable at only \$46 per unit for California residents (about \$1,380 per year for a full-time, 12-unit course load).

Are PACE students eligible for DVC's free tuition program?


