For Chinese 121

Write one hand-written page in Mandarin Chinese to describe your daily routine: what you do every day; what you did last weekend; and what you are going to do on your next vacation.

For Chinese 220

Write one to one-and-a-half hand-written pages in Mandarin Chinese to why you are interested in taking this class.

For Chinese 221

Write one to one-and-a-half hand-written pages in Mandarin Chinese describing one or more aspects of Chinese culture.
